## Cemetery

As a courtesy and privilege to our members, First Baptist Church Maddoxtown maintains a cemetery where, upon death, each can be laid to rest. The following guidelines are used:

- **1.** The cemetery is for First Baptist Church Maddoxtown members as defined in Article IV of the church bylaws. All members have a plot by default.
- **2.** Upon termination of membership, as defined in Article IV, Section 4 of the church bylaws, burial in the cemetery is forfeited.
- **3.** Upon death of a member the location of plots is the next available. Surviving members who desire to be buried beside a family member may reserve up to two plots for a \$25 nonrefundable fee per plot. The reservation needs to be done at the time of death and is nontransferable. In no case will there be more than 2 reserved per member, per family.
- **4.** Upon termination of membership, as defined in Article IV, Section 4 of the church bylaws, the reservation is also terminated. Under no circumstances will members be allowed to select the location of plots.
- **5.** As of review of this policy October, 2011, prior reservations were made by nonmembers. A grandfather clause will be instituted to honor any reservation made by nonmembers prior to September, 2011.
- **6.** If a member moves away, remains a member, as defined in Article IV of the church bylaws, and returns, they will still have the right of burial in our cemetery.
- **7.** If an elderly member has to move with their children because they are unable to take care of themselves, they will still be able to be buried in the Maddoxtown cemetery.
- **8.** When our current pastor is not a member an exception will be made for him. If his family chooses to bury him at Maddoxtown a plot will be provided.
- **9.** Any member having custody of minor child (aged 12 and under) or person incapable of making decisions for themselves concerning salvation, who is attending Maddoxtown and has not become a member may be recommended by a combined committee of deacons and trustees to be allowed to be buried in the Maddoxtown cemetery.
- **10.**We do not sell plots to non-members.

## Addendum (08/13/2016)

- **11.** All headstones must be at the head of the grave and in compliance with church policy.
- **12.**The addition of live planted shrubs, flowers, etc. is not permitted due to upkeep of cemetery plots. Only artificial fwreaths, flowers are allowed.
- **13.** All decorations must be removed by June 15<sup>th</sup>. All will be removed and disposed of after June 15<sup>th</sup>.

**14.** In the event of death of a First Baptist Church Maddoxtown member, it is the responsibility of the family to contact the church's designated person to make arrangements for a burial plot.

## Proposed Addendum (12/12/2018)

**15.** Any member not in good standing may request to have the funeral service at Maddoxtown, however, the church will not provide a meal.

## Addendum (05/11/2019)

**16.** Upon death, family of deceased members will be required to make a nonrefundable deposit for the purchase of a granite marker to be placed on the grave. The marker will be approximately 16"x10" and only contain the name and date of death. If a headstone has not been placed within 3 months after burial, the marker will be used. If/when a headstone is placed, the marker will be returned to the family. Cost will be at market value at the time of death.
